Primary and Alternate AMFA– DH JSAP ERC Representatives Election Notice

AMFA National is conducting an election for the AMFA Local 2 Independence Air membership for the positions of Primary and Alternate AMFA–Independence Air (DH) Joint Safety Action Program (JSAP) Event Review Committee (ERC) Representatives.

The Primary AMFA JSAP Representative will serve as the DH membership's representative on the Independence Air JSAP ERC. The Alternate will serve in the event the Primary is unavailable. This is anticipated to be a part-time assignment. The term of service will commence on the first day of the month following the certification of the election and will expire at 11:59 PM ET, June 30, 2006, or upon termination of the program, whichever occurs first.

The secret ballot election for the above positions will be conducted by mail. All active members in good standing of AMFA employed by DH are eligible to vote in this election. Ballots will be mailed to the last known address of all eligible voters by March 7, 2005. Any member who has not received a ballot by March 18, 2005, or any member who spoils a ballot must submit a written request for a duplicate ballot to AMFA National no later than March 25, 2005. If you request another ballot, only the replacement ballot will be counted.

Ballots must be returned to the PO Box used for this purpose in sufficient time to be received by 10 AM ET April 4, 2005, the date of the ballot count. The election results will be posted no later than April 5, 2005. The candidate receiving this highest number of votes will be declared the Primary AMFA JSAP ERC Representative. The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes will be declared the Alternate. In the event of a tie vote, a runoff election will be conducted by mail. Ballots for the runoff election will be mailed by April 11, 2005, counted May 9, and posted May 10.

In an effort to provide AMFA members with basic information about candidates for union office, AMFA National has offered all candidates in this election an opportunity to submit a candidate profile along with their picture. Candidate profiles may be viewed on the AMFA National Web site at <http://www.amfanatl.org> under the heading Elections and Referenda.
